

**MINUTES of CLOK COMMITTEE – Monday 13th January, 2014
held at the Leisure Centre, Guisborough.**

2. **MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING** were approved.
3. **MATTERS ARISING** from the December minutes.
 - 3²⁰.5 ODP LEAD – Joan, Joe & Peter have had an initial meeting. **On going**
 - 3.3.8 CLOK TOPS are now ordered and will be arriving at the end of February.
 9. LEVEL B CONTROLLERS COURSE – Paul Taylor suggests we get together with the NWOA.
Paul will contact Angela Whitworth to see if any training course is in the offing.
Duncan will contact other local clubs to see if anyone is interested in attending.
4. Quality of **PRINTING from the OK1 301 PRINTER** – **Peter Archer will arrange a suitable time to call and try to improve the print quality.**
5. **HOW DO WE GET WHOLE FAMILIES TO REGISTER with BO/CLOK** – Maureen reports that so far we have 108 Seniors and 30 Juniors who have renewed with BO/CLOK - 42 have lapsed. Maureen has e-mailed everyone on the lapsed list and 11 have renewed since.
