It was decided to discontinue evening activities at the end of this school term at Darlington and Guisborough and go with coaching/training days once a month on a Saturday utilising local woods and parks. Rob said that he would continue with the informal weekly training as in recent months i.e. meeting up to go for a run sometimes with some navigation.

- Charge maybe £2 to attend a session.
