
Membership Report 2025

132 members in total for 2025, down from 143 last year. Overall membership looks to have remained consistent over the last six years; however this year is the lowest number in these records.

In total twenty-five people did not renew this year. We sadly lost Bill Hodgson. 2 members retired from active O and took up social membership. 3 people moved out of the catchment and two others transferred to other clubs. 2 ex members responded that time constraints meant that O was not currently an option for them, the fifteen others did not respond to our request for feedback. Ten of the non-renewals were new members in 2024. We have twelve new members this year, 4 of these transferred in for other clubs.

I have added an extra row to this year's table in an attempt to demonstrate how many members are actively orienteering. The Eighty-four figure is the number of CLOK members shown as having ranking points on the BO web site dated 23 September. There are a number of issues with this number – it excludes anybody under 16 (we have 9), it includes at least 7 people I know to be no longer active for CLOK, there will be other members who do participate but fall outside the scoring criteria of the BO system and there is no credit given to those who put so much into volunteering for the club without competing.
