Richard – befriending/mentoring new members/beginners. Offering gentle encouragement to move on from parks/ urban events to “proper” areas and bigger events.

Anne – mentioned that Duncan Archer had already audited the club website, and that the newcomers section needs an editor and that it has not been updated.

Charles – getting beginners signed up to Tchimes so they get regular reminders and information possibly by advertising it at download, **Action. Joe to investigate advertising Tchimes on Racesignup.**
